**PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENT
RE: RTC PRINCIPAL**

At our Board meeting on Monday 12th November 2018, Murray Capill indicated his desire to step down as Principal of the RTC at the end of 2019. Fortunately, he also indicated a willingness and desire to continue to serve the College as a lecturer and in his wider speaking ministry, if the Board wishes. The Board is keen to retain Murray's services, given his longstanding involvement with the College and his giftedness as a lecturer and preacher.

The Board will now work through the process of finding a suitable replacement for Murray as Principal of the RTC. At the same time the Board will determine a way to retain Murray's services that will free him up to focus on his passion for teaching and nurturing ministry students, as well as broadening the RTC's ministry. This process may take time, and we will keep all members and supporters updated as to our progress.

The decision to step down from the Principal's role is not one that Murray has taken lightly. He has been Principal of the RTC for the past 11 years, and been a lecturer in Pastoral Ministry at the College for 17 years. Over the past four years Murray has overseen the development and implementation of the most significant changes in the RTC's 63-year history, with the move of the campus to Melbourne and the delivery of theological education in a variety of different modes. These changes have been profound, and have enhanced the RTC's reputation and accessibility. Under his leadership there has also been a complete renewal of the teaching faculty, as well as the appointment of a new General Manager. Murray is now seeking a change of pace and focus.

Please pray for the Board as it determines a way forward so the RTC can continue to build on the wonderful progress that has been made in repositioning the College as a provider of excellent reformed theological training for life and ministry. ■
